The Certificate Course core curriculum includes didactic information, hands on lab work in which participants practice problem solving and application of intervention strategies, treatment demonstrations by instructors, and mentored clinical practice in which participants work with a variety of clients. Instruction in the Contemporary Practice of NDT is an interdisciplinary team approach that assures that all therapists learn to address each client using a holistic approach. Throughout the course, therapists assess and treat clients with neuromuscular disorders to gain a thorough understanding of each individual's underlying posture and movement impairments and function.
